## FIRE HYDRANT FLUSHING SCHEDULED OCTOBER 13TH-15TH



The Public Works Department wants residents to be aware that they are planning scheduled *fire hydrant flushing* around town Oct 13th-15th.

Remember to check your water for discoloration before washing light or white clothes during this time.

The water will be safe to drink and use, but flushing hydrants stirs up sediment in the lines and temporarily discolors the water.

We have an extremely professional service but our number of volunteer members is becoming smaller each year. To become a member and serve your community as a volunteer is very simple. **Would your house number be visible at night from the street? Could the ambulance, police or firemen easily find your home in an emergency? Even a few minutes lost could make a difference between life and death, or a good outcome or bad one...**

Homes and businesses in Lawton are required by code to have the building number in a place conspicuous to the street in figures not less than 4" in height and of a contrasting color with their background.

Go outside tonight and look at your house from the street. Are your numbers visible and readable? Do your shrubs need to be pruned back away from the numbers? Do you need to replace the porch light so they can be illuminated at night? These simple things could make all the difference in the world during an emergency situation.
