

Lawton City Council Minutes

May 25, 2010

The Lawton City Council met in Special session on Tuesday, May 25, 2010, at the Lawton City Hall. Meeting called to order at 5:00 pm by Mayor Jeff Nitzschke. Council members answering roll: Rick Schorg, Terry Masching, Don Grigg and Perry Ludwig. Others attending were City Clerk Patricia Washburn and Attorney Glenn Metcalf. Fire Chief Nick Lahrs joined the meeting already in progress.

Motion to approve agenda was made by Ludwig, seconded by Grigg. Motion carried on roll 4-0.

Mayor welcomed guests.

Purpose of this meeting was to hold Public Hearings for the sale of several pieces of equipment and to approve the city budget amendment for fiscal year 2010.

Public Hearings were opened at 5:00 pm regarding proposed sale of McCormick tractor and accessories, 1977 Fire Truck, generator and fire ladders. No one was present to give oral comment. Clerk reported one verbal communication left today at noon on City Hall answering machine from Fire Chief Lahrs regarding desire to have \$200 reserve on generator. Generator was listed without reserve. At this time it would require Council to pass a new resolution, republish Public Hearing Notice and hold new Public Hearing. Motion to close Public Hearings made by Grigg, second by Masching. Motion carried on roll 4-0. Mayor declared Public Hearings closed at 5:05 p.m.

Motion by Grigg, second by Ludwig to approve the sales as previously proposed and to authorize the Clerk to advertise the sale of such items as presented. Motion carried 4-0.

Councilman Burson arrived at 5:10 pm.

Mayor opened Public Hearing for City Fiscal Year 2010 Budget Amendment at 5:07 p.m.. No one was present to give oral comments and no oral or written comments were received prior to Public Hearing. Motion by Grigg, second by Burson to close Public Hearing and proceed with Budget Amendment as presented. Motion carried 5-0. Mayor declared Public Hearing closed at 5:13 p.m.

Lahrs arrived and stated he wanted \$200 reserve on generator. Council stated sale would be as proposed. Lahrs requested Council attend Fire Association meeting on June 3. He stated two Association members would attend June 1 Council meeting.

Council discussed correspondence received from property owner of 404 E Main St regarding nuisance abatement order issued. Mayor will investigate if nuisance was abated.

With no further business to come before the meeting, meeting was adjourned at 6:00 pm.
