

Lawton City Council Minutes

May 20, 2014

The Lawton City Council met in Special session on Tuesday, May 20, 2014, at the Lawton City Hall. Meeting was called to order at 5:30 pm by Mayor Rick Schorg. Council members answering roll: Terry Masching, Will Wollesen, Perry Ludwig and Don Grigg. Matt Otto arrived at 5:35 p.m. Also in attendance were City Clerk Patricia Washburn, Howard & Verna Smith, Jeff Nitzschke, Jerry Steffen, Kent Baker and Tyler Manker.

Purpose of this special meeting was two-fold, to award contract for Elm Street Reconstruction Project and to consider employment applications.

Nitzschke asked Council for clarification regarding sewer lines for duplex in West Creek Development. Council stated duplexes will have two water lines and two sewer lines. No changes were made from previous discussions on matter.

Motion by Wollesen, second by Masching, to award Elm Street Reconstruction Project contract to Sioux City Engineering for the low bid of \$320,050 with a completion date of December 1, 2014. Motion carried on roll 5-0.

Council reviewed applications and chose two applicants to interview in upcoming days. Clerk will contact applicants and schedule interviews.

Council discussed matter of trailers parked on streets. Project managers will be contacted.

With no further business to come before the meeting, meeting adjourned at 6:12 pm.
