Water meter readings are taken around the 20th day of each month.
Invoices for water, sewer, garbage and landfill are sent on the 1st of each month.
These invoices are delinquent if not paid by the 20th of that same month.
A 10% Late Fee will be assessed on all delinquent accounts.

Garbage will be picked up Saturday, July 2, rather than Monday, July 4, due to Independence Day.

Pets

- ⇒ Tags were due June 30. Late fees will be assessed beginning August 1.
- ⇒ All dogs and cats must be licensed if they are at least 3 months of age.
- ⇒ Pets are to be leashed, fenced or kept indoors at all times.
- ⇒ If you take your dog out for a walk, carry a bag to pick up his/her feces. Other property owners do NOT enjoy finding piles in their yards. If you send your children out to walk the dog, make sure they understand they need to clean up after him/her, also.
- ⇒ Please keep your pets hydrated with the hot summer heat. Give them plenty of shade if they are kept outside.
- ⇒ Dogs and cats found running at-large will be taken into the Humane Society.

ATTENTION CITY OF LAWTON LANDOWNERS

Pursuant to City Ordinance Code, Section 3-11-3, it is the duty of the owner or owners to cut or destroy weeds or grass that have exceeded twelve inches in height before they bloom or seed, and in any event, by the 15th day of the month from May through October.

Failure to comply with the provisions of Section 3-11-3 will result in the City Weed Commissioner mowing, cutting or removing the weeds, and the cost of the labor and material being billed to the landowner. Such cost will not be less than \$50 and is to be paid to the City of Lawton within thirty days. Failure to pay within 30 days will result in costs being added to property taxes.

The City of Lawton of Lawton has a tree pile on the west end of Main Street that you may take your trees and branches to for grinding. Professional tree trimmers may also use the site at no cost as long as they are cutting trees within Lawton. However, they must register at City Hall prior to using the tree pile site. Please note: The City does NOT provide a public dumping site for concrete, grass clippings, building materials, or other garbage. These items need to be taken to the County Landfill for disposal.
