

Please be sure your house numbers are visible and easy to read from the street. It is recommended that you use numbers at least 4" to 6" in height. It is not necessary that they are reflective in nature, however they should be a contrasting color from the background to aid emergency responders.

Also, if possible, PLEASE turn on a porch light or other outdoor light to bring attention to your home in an emergency situation.

It has come to my attention that several of our homes do not have addresses that are visible from the street. For the sake of those in your home, please take time to make sure your numbers are easy to read from the street.
