Upcoming Street Work

The City will be opening bids for an upcoming construction project at the July 2 Council meeting. We will be removing and replacing the intersection of Cedar Street and Birch Street. This is the intersection north of Pronto, in front of the telephone company.

There will be detours in place as Cedar Street will not be passable from north to south in front of Western Iowa Telephone. You will still be able to access Western Iowa Telephone from East Birch Street.

Residents directly affected (100 and 200 block of Cedar, 100 block of East Birch and all of West Birch Street) will be contacted by the City once we have a more definite time frame, but we are asking all construction work be completed no later than October 31.

Traffic will be re-routed through the city using Elm Street and West Creek Lane as entrances/exits to and from Highway 20. We know there will be some congestion and we ask your cooperation during this time. The City Council believes the end result will be well worth the inconvenience.

CITY ELECTION - November 5, 2013

Two Council seats and the Mayoral seat are up for election this year. Those positions are currently held by Reed Burson, Terry Masching and Jeff Nitzschke respectively.

Nomination papers may be picked up at City Hall, the County Courthouse, or online at the Secretary of State website. They must be brought back between August 26 and 5:00 p.m. September 19.

Council members are elected on a staggering four-year term. That is, two seats are elected this year, three seats will be elected in 2015. Council members serve for four years. The Mayor is elected to a two-year term.
