November 5, 2013

Two Council seats and the Mayoral seat are up for election this year. Those positions are currently held by Reed Burson, Terry Masching and Jeff Nitzschke respectively.

Reed Burson and Rick Schorg are both running for Mayor. In the event Reed Burson should win the election, Rick Schorg will remain on Council and will finish his term of another two years.

In the event Rick Schorg should win the election, his seat on Council will be vacant and Council will need to decide on an appointment or a special election to fill that seat.

Those running for Council are incumbent Terry Masching and newcomers Mike Frolkey, Matt Otto and William Wollesen. Two Council seats will be filled at the November election.

You may cast your votes at the Friendship Center from noon-8:00 p.m. on November 5.



### Yard Waste Carts

Generally our GREEN yard waste carts are emptied only through the first week in November. However since most of our trees still have leaves, Novak Sanitary Service has stated they will continue to empty the green yard waste carts through the end of November. Your December 1st invoice will show your last fee for the year.

At that time, we ask that you store your yard waste carts through the winter months unless you do not feel that you will be using the service again in the spring.
