Construction to Begin on Elm Street

We have just received word from our engineer, Jerry Steffen, that the contractor for the Elm Street reconstruction project is planning to begin the week of September 8th if weather allows.

There will be a special informational meeting for the public with the Contractor and Engineer on Wednesday, September 3rd at 6:30 p.m. in the Friendship Center at 300 Cedar St.

The scope of the work to be done is the removal, widening and replacement of the existing street from Highway 20 north three blocks to Maple Street. A few trees will have to be removed, but we anticipate that to be a small number.

Please bring your questions and concerns to this meeting. If you are unable to attend, you may contact City Hall prior to the meeting with your concerns so they are discussed at this meeting. Feel free to leave a message on the City Hall answering machine including your name and number.

Please watch the electronic sign downtown for updates. We realize there will be some inconvenience during the next few months, but we ask for your patience in this matter.

Early Warning Siren

The early warning siren is now installed and almost ready for it's initial testing. Please watch your email and the electronic sign downtown for updated information on when this first test will actually be held.

After the initial test, the siren will be sounded on a routine basis. Most likely it will coincide with the schedule set up by the Woodbury County Communications Center.

In the event of bad weather, the Comm. Center will sound the siren for us. When you hear this, take shelter immediately in the lower level of the building, away from doors and windows.

Discuss safety plans with your family so they know what to do in case of a weather emergency.
